Please check in with the clerk. The clerk will put an identification (ID) band on your wrist. Your ID will be checked often.

You will be given a number. Your number is called when it is your turn to come into the Chemo Suite.

Visitors

One healthy visitor may stay with you. Children under 16 years are not allowed in a Chemo Suite.

Pills

Bring any pills that you need to take when you are here at the JCC such as your pain pills and your anti-vomiting pills.

Food

Patients may eat while having chemo. Visitors are asked not to eat in the Chemo Suite.

Need to leave

If you need to leave the Chemo waiting area, please check with the clerk before leaving.

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Cell phones

Please put all cell phones to vibrate. Texting is allowed. Please refrain from talking on cell phones in the Chemotherapy Suite. Land lines are available for phone calls.

If needed, we will provide a headset when you first come to the Chemo Suite. Please bring it with you for each visit. Feel free to bring in your own headset.

Checklist for chemo suite:

- Bring your health card.
- 2. Take your regular medications unless told otherwise.
- Bring your regular medications, especially your anti-vomiting, pain and diabetic medication(s).
- Bring a current list of your medications.
- Wear comfortable clothes.

- 7. Bring a book or activity.
- 8. Bring food or money to buy lunch.
- 9. Eat a low fat meal.
- 10. If the weather is bad, call us.

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
