## Making baby formula from liquid concentrate

## How to prepare

1. Wash hands with soap and warm water.
2. Boil all utensils for 2 minutes. Let cool.
3. Heat water in a pot or kettle to a rolling boil for at least 2 minutes. Do not use a kettle that shuts off before the water has boiled for 2 minutes. Let cool.
4. Wash the top of the can with hot water.
5. Add $\qquad$ of formula concentrate to the boiled sterile container.
6. Add $\qquad$ of cooled, boiled water to make a final measure of $\qquad$ ml

8. Mix well.
9. Divide into $\qquad$ bottles of $\qquad$ each or store in the boiled, sterile container.
10. Place bottles in the fridge right away. Use prepared formula within 24 hours. If not used in 24 hours, then throw away.
11. If there is liquid concentrate formula left, cover the open can and store it in the fridge. Use within 24 hours.
