

OHIP+ is here!

With OHIP+, more than 4,400 drug products are free for anyone 24 years or younger.

Who is covered?

Anyone 24 and under with a valid Health Card is automatically covered by OHIP+.

What is covered?

OHIP+ will pay for:

- All drugs currently available through the Ontario Drug Benefit program (ODB).
- Drugs that are approved by the Exceptional Access Program.



Take your prescription and Health Card (or health card number) to any pharmacy in Ontario. If the medication is covered, the pharmacy will fill your prescription at no charge. You don't pay a dispensing fee, deductible or co-payment.

What if I have other coverage?

OHIP+ will pay for eligible drugs, even if you have other coverage. You won't need to use other funds, such as private insurance or the Trillium Drug Program.
