Prostate Biopsy

After your procedure:

- If needed, take an over-the-counter pain medication.
- Take all of your antibiotics as told to by your doctor.
- You can return to your normal activities after the procedure.
- Drink plenty of fluids.
- You will have to urinate before going home.

What to watch for:

You may have blood in your urine or from your rectum for up to 2 weeks. You may also have blood in your ejaculate or semen for up to 2 months. This blood goes from a pinkish colour to brown.

Call your doctor if you:

- Have large amounts of bright red blood in your urine or from your penis or rectum.
- Are not able to urinate.
- Have a fever and/or chills.
- Have increasing pain in the lower part of your abdomen.

You may be given a follow-up appointment when you leave the hospital. If not, your surgeon's office will call you.
