


How do I care for my son's uncircumcised penis?

Gently clean his penis each time you change his diaper. At bath time, wash his penis with mild soap and warm water, rinse well and pat dry. No special care, ointments or creams are needed.

A covering of skin called the foreskin protects the tip of his penis (glans). If your son's foreskin naturally retracts, you can gently pull it back to wash his penis at bath time. If it does not retract, do not force it back.

It is normal to see a little white or yellow substance under the foreskin. This is called smegma. Gently wipe it away during a diaper change or bath.



At birth, the foreskin is attached to the glans. As your son grows, the foreskin and glans will gradually separate.
