Nuclear Medicine Adult Patient Instructions

Biliary Scan	Nothing to eat or drink for at least 4 hours prior to test. Test duration - 90 minutes.
Bone Scan	No preparation required. Two parts to exam. First portion lasts up to 30 minutes with patient returning 2.5-4 hours later for the second portion of imaging for 1 hour.
Carbon 14 Breath Test	Nothing to eat or drink 6 hours before the test. Medication restrictions are provided at time of booking. Test duration 30 minutes.
Gastric Emptying	Nothing to eat or drink for at least 12 hours, prior to test. Liquid emptying test duration - 45 minutes. Solid emptying test duration - 4.5 hours. May be completed for patient either on or off medication, at physicians discretion (please indicate). If patient is directed not to take medication, then they must be off medication for at least 24 hours. (E.g. domperidone / motilium, metoclopramide / reglan, tegaserod / zelnorm.)
Lung Scan	No patient preparation. Test duration - 1 hour.
Renal Scan	Patient to drink 2 glasses of water prior to scheduled test. Check with physician for discontinuation of any medication prior to appointment. Test duration 1.5 hours.
Thyroid Scan	In almost all cases, anti-thyroid medications must be discontinued for 5 days and thyroid hormone replacement medication must be discontinued for 4 weeks. Two-day appointment. First day a capsule is given and uptake is measured 4 hours later. Second day, patient returns for a second uptake and imaging (90 minutes).
White Blood Cell (Indium)	Two-day test. First day has two parts which each take 45 minutes, with 4-5 hours between parts. Patient should be prepared to be available for the whole day. Next day patient returns for imaging (2 hours). Please notify our office if the patient is on dialysis.
White Blood Cell (HMPAO)	Possible two-day test. First day has three parts which each take 45 minutes. Patient should be prepared to be available entire day for test. Patient may return next day for additional imaging and will be notified on first day. Please notify our office if patient is on dialysis.
