<p>Speech and Language Volunteer</p> <p>Act as an additional conversational partner for patients in individual therapy with the Speech-Language Pathologist in order to encourage carryover of newly acquired communication skills, create and prepare therapy materials using printed resources of the SLP department.</p>	<p>Monday – Friday 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.</p>
<p>Special Event Volunteer</p> <p>Help with set-up and tear down of events, assist by volunteering to plan or help at fundraisers such as: Grandparents Day, Festival of Lights.</p>	<p>Various & Ongoing</p>
