


Airborne/Contact Precautions





Airborne/Contact Precautions are used when the germs are spread by tiny droplets in the air.

- Your child will stay in a room with a special air filter that removes germs from the air.
- The door must be closed.
- Keep the window vents clear so air flow is not blocked.

To protect yourself and others:

- Wash your hands before and after caring for your child.
- ✓ Wear a gown when caring for your child.
- ✓ Wear gloves when caring for your child.
