



Protect patients with CF from infection

These guidelines will help to protect you and your family from germs, which could cause infections.

- Patients with CF should wear a mask throughout the hospital.
- Everyone should wash their hands with hand sanitizer or soap and water when entering and leaving clinic rooms.
- Parents and caregivers should bring activities from home for their children.
- If your child is going to touch toys or screens in waiting areas (although this is not recommended), please clean them first with disinfecting wipes available from staff.
- Staff will wear gowns and gloves when they may come into contact with mucous secretions.
