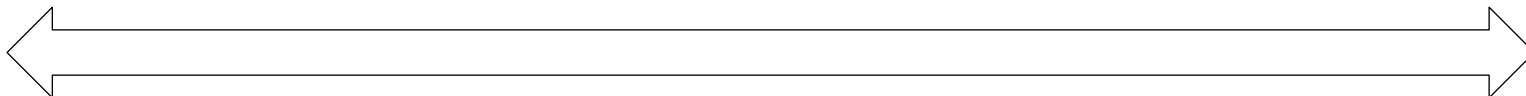
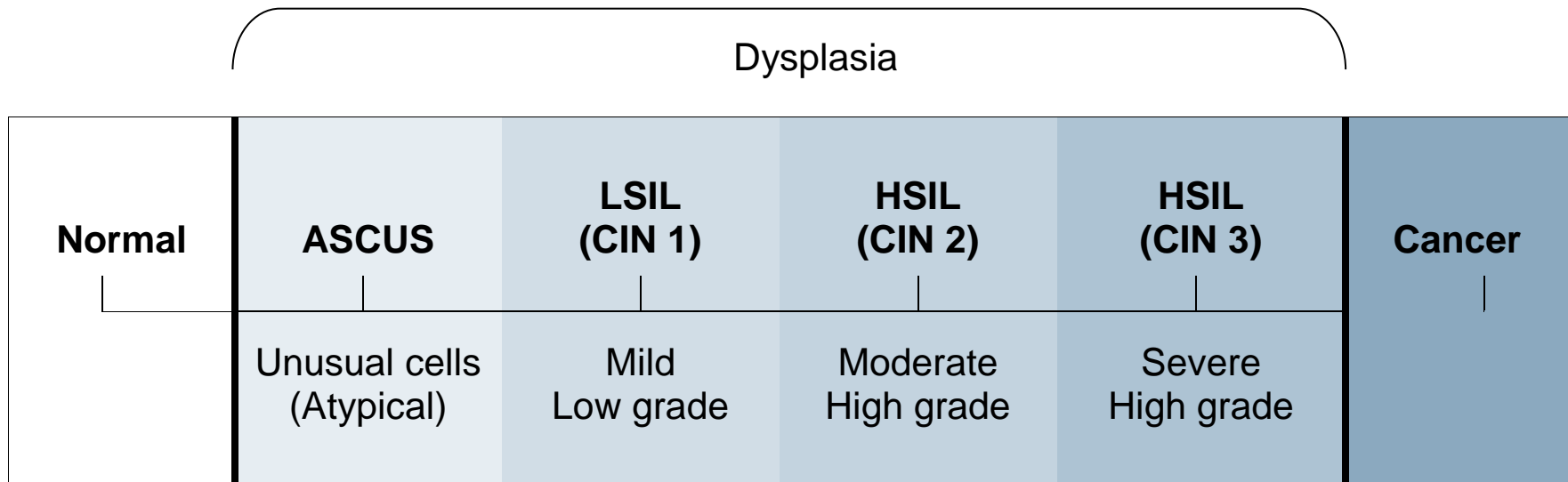


# Understanding Cervical Dysplasia

Your Pap test showed some abnormal changes in the cells on your cervix. This is called cervical dysplasia. There are many levels or ‘stages’ of dysplasia. Your care provider will explain your results and show you where they fit on the range below.

You will have more Pap tests to see how the cells on your cervix change over time. Dysplasia may get better on its own, without any treatment. If dysplasia does not get better or the cells have further changes, your doctor may recommend treatment. The goal is to watch the cells carefully and treat dysplasia before it develops into cancer.
