- You will have an appointment with the medical oncologist every 3 weeks a few days prior to your chemotherapy treatment.
- You will have an appointment with the radiation oncologist each week on _____.

- You will receive intravenous fluids (IV-H) at home for _____ days after chemotherapy.

General treatment information

- From the day you start radiation you will have daily treatments Monday to Friday for a total of 35 treatments.
- Patient assessment nurses are available daily in the Patient Review Office on Level 0 for any issues or side effects from treatment if you have any questions or concerns (for example: skin and mouth care issues).
- A dietician will see you each week to discuss proper nutrition during your treatment.
