

Droplet/Contact Precautions



Droplet/Contact Precautions are used when the germs are spread by large droplets from coughing and sneezing, and by touching surfaces that the droplets have landed on.

To protect yourself and others:

- ✓ Wash your hands before and after caring for your child.
- ✓ Wear a gown when in direct contact with your child.
- ✓ Wear gloves when doing direct care for your child.
- ✓ A mask may also be required if your child is coughing or sneezing.
- ✓ When sharing a room with another patient, keep the curtain between the beds closed. This acts as a barrier between patients.
