

# OHIP+ is here!

With OHIP+, more than 4,400 drug products are free for anyone 24 years or younger.

## Who is covered?

Anyone 24 and under with a valid Health Card is automatically covered by OHIP+.

## What is covered?

OHIP+ will pay for:

- ✓ All drugs currently available through the Ontario Drug Benefit program (ODB).
- ✓ Drugs that are approved by the Exceptional Access Program.



## How do I get my medication?

Take your prescription and Health Card (or health card number) to any pharmacy in Ontario. **If the medication is covered, the pharmacy will fill your prescription at no charge.** You don't pay a dispensing fee, deductible or co-payment.

## What if I have other coverage?

OHIP+ will pay for eligible drugs, even if you have other coverage. You won't need to use other funds, such as private insurance or the Trillium Drug Program.
