## **Medication and diet**

Please take your usual medications and eat your regular diet before the procedure.

## **When you arrive for the RNA Scan**

- You will be given a small injection (usually in the arm).
- Then, there is a 20 to 30 minute wait.
- After the wait, you will be taken to an imaging room, where we will take pictures of your heart.
- Electrodes will be placed on your chest. Electrodes show us your heart beat.
- Another injection is given (usually in the arm).
- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> injection, pictures of your heart will be taken.
- In total, the scan takes about 1 hour.
