

Subcutaneous Immune Globulin (SCIG) Information for patients

Ordering SCIG

- Order SCIG from the Transfusion Medicine Department.
- Your order will be ready for pick up in 5 business days.
- Order ahead of time so you do not run out!

Picking up SCIG

- Pick up your SCIG from the Transfusion Medicine Department. You may need to wait if Transfusion Medicine staff are helping hospital inpatients.
- Bring an insulated bag to carry the SCIG home. At home, store the SCIG at room temperature or in the fridge.



Pick up dates and times are Monday to Friday, between 8 am and 6 pm ONLY.
