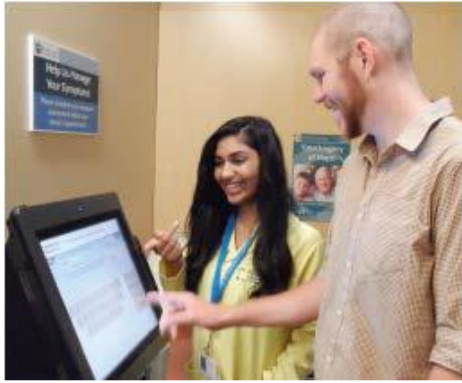


# Your symptoms matter



## What is a Symptom Assessment Screening Tool?

A symptom assessment screening tool is an electronic form that asks questions about how you are feeling on the day of your appointment. This screening tool will ask questions about specific side effects that people living with cancer may experience. Your cancer team will review your answers during your clinic appointment. This is a fast and easy way for you to let your team know how you are doing and allow them to recommend the best care based on your symptoms.

## How do you complete it?

When you come for each clinic appointment, your cancer care team will ask you to complete a symptom screening assessment on a computer or tablet in the clinic waiting area of the Juravinski Cancer Centre. You will be asked to rate the different symptoms that you may have. This symptom assessment can also be completed at home prior to your clinic visit by going online to this link:
