Applications are invited for a full time clinical laboratory scientist, specializing in genetics to serve as the Head, Molecular Genomics within the Hamilton Regional Laboratory Medicine Program (HRLMP), with an academic appointment at an appropriate rank in the Department of Pathology and Molecular Medicine at McMaster University.

The successful candidate will provide professional expertise for a large academic laboratory program serving the Central South region of Ontario. This position is a key leader within the Hamilton Regional Laboratory Medicine Program (jointly administered by Hamilton Health Sciences and St. Joseph's Healthcare, Hamilton) which has a catchment of approximately 2.5 million people. The laboratory is located at the McMaster University campus.

The current workload comes from a referral base that includes tertiary genetic, pediatric, hematology, pathology, oncology, and obstetrical services that are provided in a multi-site hospital environment. This arrangement permits the possibility of participation and responsibility across other components of genetic services in the program if desired by the candidate.

This position is for an academically oriented faculty member, who has obtained a PhD, as well as CCMG and/or ABMGG certification in molecular genetics, or dual certification in molecular genetics and cytogenetics with experience in next-generation sequencing. McMaster University's medical school has an innovative curriculum design that offers a unique teaching environment and exciting opportunities for vigorous collaborative research in medical genetics and genomics. As a full time faculty member within the Department of Pathology and Molecular Medicine, you will participate in teaching in our educational programs at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels (as appropriate); and will pursue collaborative research in your area of specialty.
