Subject: **Interim changes to retail food services at JHCC site**

In consultation with Hamilton Public Health, we have decided to temporarily close Nora's Café and the Hummingbird Café out of an abundance of caution due to a small number of presumptive and positive cases of Covid-19 at our site.

Nora's Café is closing immediately. Hummingbird Café will be closed as of tomorrow (Monday March 30). These closures include the seating areas which will undergo a thorough cleaning so that we can re-open these spaces as quickly as possible.

The Atrium Café will be open from 7 am to 5 pm daily starting tomorrow so that staff and physicians can access beverages and pre-packaged food items. There is a seating area in the atrium area that can be used by staff and physicians using appropriate distancing measures.

You are encouraged to bring your own drinks and meals as much as possible.

As always, we encourage everyone to be supportive of one another during this difficult time.
