Behavioral Health Assistant

Assist staff and enable patients to engage in a variety of activities. Interactions will reflect on the volunteer's areas of interest (i.e.: social activities, therapeutic recreation, exercise programs, etc.)

Medically Complex Friendly Visitor

To enhance quality of life for patients by providing companionship. To support staff by performing routine tasks as needed.

Restorative Care Gym Assistant

Assist in escorting patients to the physiotherapy gym or occupational therapy room. This role also involves following patients with a wheelchair during standing and walking exercises with staff, socializing and motivating patients during therapy, and assisting with wiping down equipment.
