

Getting ready for your back brace after scoliosis surgery

After your surgery, you will get a custom-made brace to protect your back and ribs as they heal. This brace is called a TLSO (Thoracolumbosacral orthosis).

- You will likely wear your back brace for 6 months after the surgery.
- The brace is made of plastic and has straps on the front.
- Wearing a snug t-shirt or undershirt under the brace makes it more comfortable and protects your skin.
- You may be able to take the brace off for sleeping and washing.
- The brace will cost between \$800 and \$3200. If you are eligible, the Assistive Devices Program (Ministry of Health) may pay 75% of the cost. If you have insurance or are receiving social assistance through the Ontario government, the cost may be partially covered as well.

Before your surgery

- Call our Prosthetics and Orthotics team at 905-521-2607.
- Ask for a 30-minute Pre-Op TLSO Measurement appointment in Prosthetics and Orthotics Department at the Ron Joyce Children's Health Centre. A map and directions is on the back of this page.
- When you come to this appointment, you may talk to the financial clerk about paying for your brace.

After your surgery

- An orthotist will come to the hospital and do a computer scan of your body.
- After 3 to 6 days, the orthotist will come back with the brace to try it on.
- Your orthopedic doctor will tell you when you are ready to go home.
- You may have your brace by the time you go home.

Driving Directions:

From Toronto

- Take QEW to Highway 403 West (to Hamilton) and take the Main Street East exit.
- 2. Continue on Main Street to Victoria Avenue for 2.8 km.
- 3. Turn left on Victoria Avenue.
- Continue on Victoria Avenue for 1.3 km and turn left at Birge Street.
- 5. Turn left onto Wellington Street.
- 6. The Ron Joyce Children's Health Centre is on the right.

From Niagara Region

- 1. Take the QEW towards Hamilton.
- 2. Take the Nicola Tesla Boulevard exit (exit 90) (formerly Burlington Street East).
- 3. Continue on Nicola Tesla Boulevard for 6.9 km.
- 4. Turn left onto Wellington Street North for 1 km.
- 5. The Ron Joyce Children's Health Centre is on the right.

From the Hamilton Mountain

- Take the Clairmount Access straight onto Victoria Avenue.
- 2. Continue on Victoria Avenue, past Barton Street.
- 3. Turn left onto Birge Street.
- 4. Turn left onto Wellington Street.
- 5. The Ron Joyce Children's Health Centre is on the right.

HSR Bus Transit:

From Toronto

- Traveling from the west Take the # 2 Barton bus traveling east. Exit at the Barton and Ferguson stop.
- Traveling from the east Take the # 2 Barton bus traveling west. Exit at the Barton and Ferguson stop.

Visitor Parking: (rates may change)

Wellington Lot

- For short term drop off and pick up, of less than 20 minutes, enter off of Wellington Street. No cost.
- For long term parking, enter off of either Wellington Street or from the north side of Barton Street.
 Daily maximum \$20. For long-term parking rate options ask at check in or contact the Parking Office 905-521-2100 ext. 44061.

Barton Street Lot

 Long term parking, enter off Barton Street from the south side. Daily flat rate \$6.

Parking Pay Station:

- Remember to take your parking ticket with you.
 The parking pay station is inside the main entrance of the Ron Joyce Children's Health Centre.
- You may also pay with a credit card at the gate when exiting.
